ASIAN PACIFIC ISLANDERS FOR PROFESSIONAL AND COMMUNITY ADVANCEMENT (APCA) AWARDS \$4,500 IN SCHOLARSHIPS

San Ramon, California – (May 7, 2008) -- Asian Pacific Islanders for Professional and Community Advancement (APCA), an employee resource group of AT&T Inc. and 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, announced today the recipients of its 2008 scholarship program. APCA is awarding a total of \$4,500 in non-renewable scholarships to six high school seniors during this scholarship cycle. This year, two of the scholarships are being awarded to children of current APCA members.

All of the scholarship recipients will be freshmen this fall and will enter an accredited college/university or vocational school. More than 50 students applied for this year's scholarships.

The scholarship program was open to:

- ✓ All full-time graduating high school seniors in good academic standing (minimum GPA 2.5 on a 4-point scale, or 3.1 on a 5-point scale), of any ethnic background, who planned to continue their education at an accredited college (2-year and 4-year) or vocational school.
- ✓ Residents of one of the following nine states or regions where APCA currently has chapters: Arizona, California, Colorado, Georgia, Illinois, Michigan, New Jersey, Texas, and the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area.

The APCA Scholarship Program judges were impressed by the scholarship and achievements of all the applicants. APCA is pleased to further its goal of promoting diversity and its advantages throughout our corporation and our communities by granting scholarships to college-bound high school students.
